Re: Closure for Makushin Pit Site, St. George Island


Dear Ms. Goetz:

The Department has reviewed your letter request of July 15, 1997 requesting closure for the above referenced site and has the following comments:

- Sampling as conducted by Hart Crowser and reported in the Expanded Site Investigation report of June 1996 indicates that no petroleum contamination was detected at this site (Site 13, Attachment A to the Two Party Agreement)

The Department agrees that "No Further Action" is required at this site and hereby assigns site 13 that status. This assignment is specifically for site 13 and no implication that any other site would be covered by this assignment should be taken.
