

GREEN VS. GOLD OPEN ACCESS

Green OA provides the same open science as the Gold OA, but without the additional fees.

Example: *Nature**

Green OA



Article accepted and peer reviewed. Edits requested and made, creating a **post-refereed, pre-publication manuscript**



Manuscript sent to NOAA IR which, after embargo, posts manuscript (*OPEN ACCESS copy*)



Publisher's version is available by subscription only (*CLOSED ACCESS*)

Green OA is sometimes referred to as "self-archiving"

Gold OA



Article accepted and peer reviewed. Edits requested and made and resubmitted. Publisher requires **additional fee** (or APC) for OA. Nature's fee is \$11,300



Article is available without a subscription (*OPEN ACCESS copy*)

Gold OA permits the use of the publisher version in the



**Nature* is considered a "Hybrid Journal," one that provides both open and closed (requires subscription) access to articles.
